Awards are given for safe drinking venues

IT was awards time for the Moreton Bay Safer Venues at North Lakes on Thursday.

Representatives of Queensland Health, Drug Arm, Queensland Police and management and staff of

licensed venues from Redcliffe, Pine Rivers and Caboolture attended a breakfast to hand out certificates to venues which have undertaken initiatives to provide safer venues for communi-

ties. ing safety near telephone stands; ATMs, and internal and external areas.

“It also included looking at the attitudes of management, happy hour and discounted drinks etc.”

Other issues that the LIAGs look at in relation to staff training is: finding out who is the designated driver when someone is unable to drive; ensuring there are services such as transport home and security; checking for syringes and other items which could prove dangerous. They also look at venues for safety exits and fire exits and talk to management about limiting service to intoxicated people of shots and doubles.

Neil Redgen of the Pine Rivers Victuallers, Trent Dixon of the Redcliffe Liquor Industry Action Group and Craig Allen of the Caboolture Corridor Liquor Action Group also spoke about their areas and the problems they had encountered. The Caboolture Corridor is the newest LIAG formed.
